Practitioner Program at Harbor-UCLA Medical Center before receiving a Master's of Science in Nursing from California State University in Long Beach.

Ms. Tobias served as a Lieutenant Officer, US Navy at the Naval Medical Center in San Diego, where she was a charge nurse in the emergency and pediatric departments. After completing military service, she joined the nursing staff of San Diego Fertility Center where she discovered her passion for helping infertile persons and couples fulfill their goals of family building.

Currently, Ms. Tobias provides comprehensive care to infertile persons, egg freezing and fertility education. At SRM she developed, and now supervises, all 3rd Party Programs. She also supervises the staff of advanced practice providers.

Among Ms. Tobias's accomplishments, honors and recognitions are her roles as: founder of Fertility Walk Hope Fund, providing monetary fertility grants; co-partner with Footsteps for Fertility, offering free IVF cycles and monetary grants at a yearly Fun Run/Walk event in Seattle to raise fertility awareness; chair of both the ASRM Nurses Professional Group and Advanced Practice Provider Group; invited speaker for ASRM Annual Meetings, Executive Council member for SART; ASRM Service Milestone Award recipient for a decade of leadership; founder and past-president of Seattle Tacoma Area Reproductive Society, a non-profit organization providing continuing education for fertility experts.
